

## **Project 2: Children in Conflict with Law: An Intervention**

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**Brief Description:** The recognition of children in conflict with law has been a recent phenomenon. Realizing the sensitivity of the issue, the current project is an extension of the earlier interventions made by the students of B.Tech. Humanities, CIC. The project aims to work for children in conflict with law and get a practical knowledge of the workings of the Juvenile Justice System. Earlier, students worked with the NGO Prayas which runs the model observation home for CCL in Delhi. As volunteers for their 'Yuva Connect' programme, they interact with CCL inside observation home as well as with those who are out of observation homes, witness the proceedings of a Juvenile Justice Board, talk to the various authorities involved in the system and visit various related institutions. The focus of the project now is on the appropriate rehabilitation of the sensitive class. Also the project aims to develop customized counselling modules addressing the psychological underpinnings of the same. Finally, the global objective of the endeavor is to improve the quality of life of CCL and prevent a relapse.
