All students of (B. Tech., BA and MME) are requested to be present at CIC on 6th September, 2018 (Thursday) to either conduct the elections or to decide their Class representatives (CRs) unanimously. From the same, three students will further be elected/ unanimously decided for forwarding their names for the 2nd tier elections at proctor's office, if required.

All students are required to either unanimously elect their class representatives (CRs) or otherwise forward their names for elections by 2 p.m., 5th September, 2018 (Wednesday), on director@cic.du.ac.in.

Eligibility for elections of students for being elected as a CR:

1. He / She should be a student pursuing regular degree course in the University;
2. Age limit for contesting 2nd tier election will be: UG: 17 to 22 years, PG: 24-25 years and M.Phil/ Ph.D.: 28 years;
3. Minimum 75 % attendance in the previous year/ Semester, as applicable;
4. No backlog of papers;
5. Must have secured at least 55 % consolidated marks in the latest final examination;
6. Not subjected to any disciplinary action in the past and should not have any criminal record.

Student advisory committee and Grievance Committee will meet all the students at 12.00 noon on 6th September, 2018 (Thursday) after collating all the representations from students of all three courses for further elections procedure and finalization of the results.
