Admission Notice for M.Sc (Mathematics Education)-2017**

1) The First Admission List to the programme M.Sc (Mathematics Education) will be displayed on July 16 (evening), 2017 at the University/CIC website.

2) The total number of seats offered in M.Sc (Mathematics Education) programme is 20. Distribution of seats under different categories is as follows:

Total Seats: (DU=10 and Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) =10)

Seat Distribution:

DU: General: 05; OBC: 02; SC:02; ST:01

JMI: General :05; Mulsim General: 03; Muslim OBC/ST: 01; Muslim Women: 01

However, seats for PwD/CW are supernumerary. (Candidates can refer information from Bulletin of Information for PG / Master Courses from PG Admission portal of the University (page no 21-26) in this regard.

3) Applicants whose names appear in the Admission lists(s) (as notified on the website) will be eligible for admission to the M.Sc (Mathematics Education) course subject to the verification of all required documents and online payment of fee within the prescribed schedule for admission

4) The applicant, whose names appear in the given “First Admission List”, shall report to Cluster Innovation Centre, Rugby Sevens Building, University Stadium as per the admission schedule given below.

5) Schedule of Admission

- **First List announcement: 16th July 2016 (Evening)**
- **Verification of Documents, Approval of Admission and Payment of online admission Fee* : 17th– 19th July, 2017**
- **Second List announcement (if required) : 24-26th July 2017**
- **Third List announcement (if required) : 31st July-2nd August 2017**

* Note:

A. *For document verification and approval of admission official working hours between 10 AM to 4 PM shall be observed.*

B. *After approval of admission, the applicant has to log on to the post-graduate admission portal to make online admission fee payment. This may be done till 12:00 noon of the next day of the given admission list deadline.*

C. *CIC may decide to have further Admission Lists, depending on the vacant seats.*

6) Applicant shall submit following documents (in original and one set of self-attested photocopies) at the time of admission:

- Admission form (submitted online)
- Class X Board Examination Certificate
- Class X Marks-Sheet
- Class XII Marks-Sheet
- Class XII Original Certificate

- Provisional Certificate and Marks-Sheet of the Qualifying Examination
- Character Certificate (recent, six months)
- SC/ST/PwD/CW Certificate (in the name of the candidate) issued by the competent authority
- OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in the name of the Candidate) issued by competent authority. In case the OBC Certificate is older than 1st April 2015, then a proof for the Non Creamy Layer Status.
- Migration Certificate: Required for those students who have passed qualifying examination from outside Delhi University
- At least two passport size self-attested photographs.

7) Only those applicants who report to CIC, with all the above mentioned documents (including qualifying examination marks-sheet), shall be marked “VERIFIED and APPROVED” on the applicant’s Admission Form.

8) The applicant will then be required to login to the Admission Portal to make the online Admission Fee payment through one of the available online payment options.

9) The admission to the programme shall not be considered complete till the payment of the online admission fee within the prescribed time limit.

10) Those applicant who report to CIC within the scheduled time limit, and meet all other requirements except for the qualifying examination mark sheet or/and migration certificate (if required), shall be marked “REPORTED” on the applicant’s Admission Form. The applicant will then be required to login to the Admission Portal to make the online Admission Fee payment through one of the available online payment options. These applicants will be allowed to submit their required documents at least seven days (23rd August 2017) before the last date (31st August 2017) of admissions in the University of Delhi.

11) Those Applicants, who do not report to CIC within the scheduled time limit of the given “Admission list”, irrespective of the fact whether all other criteria of admission are fulfilled, shall NOT be considered for Admission in any of the subsequent lists.
