

Important information for admission process to be followed for the academic year 2015-16 is as follows:

Eligibility Criterion for applying in the Course

- Graduate degree in any discipline provided the applicant has done at least two full-fledged papers in mathematics at undergraduate level.
- The students appearing in final year of undergraduate degree program (result awaited) can also apply and appear in the entrance test subject to the condition that they shall fulfill the eligibility criteria before the commencement of classes.

Number of Seats

Total number of Seats: 20 (Twenty)

Distribution of Seats:

- University of Delhi : 10 seats
- Jamia Millia Islamia : 10 seats

Reservation Policy

Admission Procedure

1. The administrative center for conducting the entire admission process for the course will be the Cluster Innovation Centre, University of Delhi.
2. The admission to the course will be through an entrance test (85% weightage) followed by an interview (15% weightage).
3. Only those applicants which will be shortlisted on the basis of entrance test will be called for interview. The number of candidates called for interview will be four times of the number of seats.
4. **There is no need to attach copies of any certificate along with the application form.**

5. Original certificates of academic records, mark-sheets, certificates for reserved seats must be produced only at the time of the interview.
6. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of the University of Delhi and Jamia Millia Islamia.

Entrance Test Details

1. The entrance test will be of one-hour duration.
2. The entrance test will contain questions based on mathematical skills, reasoning, mental ability, general awareness, communication skills in English language etc.
3. **The centers for the entrance test will only be at Delhi.**

Per Semester Fee of the Course

The per semester fee for the course will be Rs. 5000/- per student.
