

Announcement: Awareness Program on Intellectual Property Rights

Indian Patent Office (IPO) and Federation of Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) with support of Delhi University, are organizing awareness program on Intellectual Property Rights at University of Delhi on Sep. 15th 2017.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) are a set of exclusive rights protected by law which are accorded to creators or persons over their creations for a certain time period. The generation of IP largely takes place at the State level through small, medium and big industries, academic institutions and individuals. Industries have to deal with IPRs in different situations in the competitive world; infringement of IPR can be a serious offence both in the domestic and international scenarios. Academic institutions play an important role in feeding educated and skilled human resource to industries, government, teaching and R&D. The knowledge society puts heavy demands on R&D in scientific, engineering and other areas in order to respond to market needs quickly. This may call for a paradigm change in the manner research is done in the universities and emphasis would need to be placed on the practical business realities involved in technology development. The industry-academia interaction is very important for creation and utilization of intellectual property and technology advancement.

The objectives of this program are:

- To sensitize the targeted participants about IPR and their protection.
- To identify protectable innovations.
- To suggest steps for transforming innovations into proprietary assets
- To train the participants about the mechanism of accessing and using IP information for further R&D in developing new products and processes and for their use in business development.
