

Format for Quest 2017

Quest shall consist of two stages: 1) PRELIMINARY and 2) FINAL

Structure of the PRELIMINARY STAGE: - This consists of two rounds

Round1:

Written MCQ Round:

- 45 MCQ with equal weightage in Physics, Chemistry & Life sciences.
- Duration 90 Minutes

Round2:

This is an interactive round that will be held on **18 February 2017**.

- First groups of 6 or 8 teams are made.
- Each of these groups would have an independent participative session.
- In these sessions each team would be asked to pose to the rest of the teams in the group one question (pre-selected by the judges out of three questions submitted at the time of Written MCQ Round on 15 Feb 2017).
- After about 2 minutes every other team will respond to the questions. At the end the team, which posed the question, will have to present its answer and also conclude the discussion with comments on the answer of all other teams.

The final evaluation of the judges will be based on the team's ability to handle the discussions of their own question, and on their responses to questions posed by other teams.

Structure of the FINALS:-

The best six teams, based on combined performance in the Round I & II shall qualify for the FINALS.

The FINALS consist of the following two stages.

Round-I

Problem and Concept Rounds: - In this round all the teams are presented simultaneously with six questions on concepts and problems respectively in Physics, Chemistry and Life Sciences. Details of these rounds will follow later.

Round II

Exposition Round: - Each Finalist team is required to make a presentation of 30 minutes (+ 10 minutes for questions and discussion) on any current interesting topic related to science and technology.
